Read Together: Luke 16

Main Idea: Christian living involves stewarding worldly goods for the good of the King and His Kingdom.

Points from the Text:

- God's people are to steward their resources in ways that reflect kingdom living and serve to help others.
- You must prove yourself trustworthy in small tasks before you will be considered capable of greater tasks.
- Preparing for eternity is more important than gathering riches for tomorrow.

Based on this passage and by the help of the Spirit, "I will _____"

- Make heaven my supreme goal in life.
- Trust Jesus for my eternal security
- Leverage worldly resources for Jesus' purposes
- Guard against making money/possessions an idol in my life

Now What? (Questions for discussion from Luke 16)

1. How does keeping eternity in view impact the way you live?
2. In what ways are you tempted to serve two masters?
3. What is your response to the realities of heaven and hell? How might the Spirit be leading you as you consider these eternal realities?
4. Close in prayer. Pray to be used by the Lord to present the gospel hope to friends, family, and peers in school. Pray for boldness and the wisdom to discern how to best manage our resources for the King and His Kingdom.
